The 2008 T'Gallant Juliet Moscato is pale straw in colour with a beautiful effervescence. The nose displays intense lifted floral and fresh fruit aromatics leading to fine fresh fruit flavours on the front palate. A crisp, lemon zesty acidity balances this luscious wine and supports the weight of flavour through the fine, crisp finish.
