T'Gallant is the sailor's abbreviation of topgallant, the top sail of square-rigger sailing ships. It connotes the peak, the best, the epitome. T'Gallant's winemaking philosophy is the same. Winemaker Kevin McCarthy is driven by an extraordinary commitment to quality. The very best European winemaking techniques and philosophies have been applied and the results can be seen in the glass.

## T'Gallant T'Gallant Juliet Moscato 2010

The 2010 T'Gallant Juliet Moscato is pale straw in colour with a beautiful effervescence. Bright aromatics with pungent scents of tropical flowers are followed by a crisp palate, with lush, fleshy Muscat fruit filling the back palate.

### Viticulture

This wine was sourced from premium vineyards from the Murray Darling and Riverina regions. These regions enjoyed warm seasons with little rainfall prior to budburst, although there was above average rainfall during the growing season. No frost or hail was recorded and low disease pressure was also a blessing - delivering fruit with bright, fresh varietal characters.

### Viniculture

The 2010 T'Gallant Juliet Moscato offers an aromatic white Moscato true to the Italian wine style. Fermentation was carefully monitored and temperatures were dropped to halt fermentation - achieving the right balance of residual sweetness and alcohol. Once this point was reached, the wine was settled in stainless steel and bottled young and fresh.

### Suggested Food

Ideal as an aperitif, with summer salads or fruit based desserts.

### Cellaring

Drink in its youth when it's young and fresh - now to 2012.
