Mornington Peninsula

Vintage Conditions

A good year for Pinot Gris on the Peninsula. Periods of rain around flowering meant that yields were lower than average but nonetheless the quality was excellent. A burst of warm weather in late February pushed along ripening and low disease pressure meant we could take our time making picking decisions.

A significant power and weight on the palate; opulent yet dry. Full of richness and ripeness, with a balanced, yet subtle, acidity. A significant, mouth-filling texture.
