



T'Gallant Cyrano Pinot Noir 2019

Deep garnet in colour; there are lifted cherry and red berry fruits combined with complexing spice and forest floor notes. Savoury spice and juicy cherry flavours combine with cedary oak characters, all framed by textural, yet fine tannins. This Pinot Noir is a wine of complexity and intensity.

Vineyard region

Mornington Peninsula

Vintage conditions

A cool winter with good rainfall was followed by cool spring conditions, resulting in good fruit set. Summer temperatures were average to warm, with persistent fine conditions and little rain, resulting in moderate yields and very good quality.

On the palate there are flavours of red cherries and blackcurrants combined with complex gamey characters and a silky tannin structure
